

Stainless Steel Care & Maintenance

Cleaning and Maintenance

- Clean stainless steel surfaces regularly to maintain appearance and prevent staining.
- For stainless steel finishes, use a soft cloth. A mild soap and water solution may be used to remove stubborn dirt.
- After cleaning, rinse thoroughly with clean water and dry completely
- For PVD-coated stainless steel finishes, use a soft cloth with warm soapy water.
- For tougher marks and splatters, or to add a protective layer, use a gentle Stainless-Steel cleaner. Apply with a soft cloth for best results.
- Cleaning stainless steel surfaces regularly will maintain appearance.



Avoid

- Steel wool, metal brushes or scourers used on ordinary steel.
- Harsh detergents (including chemical cleaners) such as bleach or abrasive cream cleansers.
- Scrubbing against the grain or using plastic scourers in random motions.



Spillages

- Salt, salty food, or citrus juice – rinse off thoroughly with clean water and wipe dry.
